

MINUTES OF THE 5th MEETING OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE FOR EVALUATION /
SELECTION OF AGENCIES UNDER JUTE INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT SCHEME

1. In accordance with NJB's letter No. 04/JIDS/5SC/Minutes/17-18 dated 04.09.2017, the 5th Meeting of the Sub-Committee for evaluation / selection of agencies under Jute Integrated Development Scheme (JIDS) was held on 13.09.2017 in the O/o The Jute Commissioner.
2. The following Sub-Committee Members / Officials were present :
 - a) Shri Dipankar Mahto, Dy. Jute Commissioner, – in Chair
 - b) Shri Arvind Kumar M., Secretary, NJB
 - c) Prof. Bibekananda Banerjee – Representative of Director, NIFT
 - d) Shri Debashish Ganguly - Representative of CGM, NABARD
 - e) Shri Apurba Roychowdhury – Representative of Chairman, JPDEPC
 - f) Prof. Swapan Kumar Ghosh – HOD-DJFT (not present)

3. Secretary, NJB welcomed all the members of the Sub-Committee and the participants. The meeting started with review of performance of 32 JIDS collaborating agencies. Statewise list of agencies is enclosed at Annexure-II.
4. During the review of JIDS collaborating agencies performance, one of the agency viz. M/s. Malda Vivekananda Seva Kendra, Malda, West Bengal was reported not satisfactory and it is decided to discontinue.
5. The members suggested that the details of all the beneficiaries, Master Trainer, Designer and product details etc. of JIDS programme must be updated on the web-portal and the JIDS agency shall facilitate extending the necessary credit linkage / Bank and local State Govt. Schemes support and generate market orders so that the participants after training are ready to produce market orders to generate income / livelihood support.
6. Jute raw materials pertaining to JIDS activities are to be mandatorily purchased from the Jute Raw Material Bank (JRMB) and / or Jute Mills. NJB to circulate list of operating JRMBs to all JIDS agencies.
7. During the training programme, the JIDS agencies shall update the details of the raw material procured i.e. type of the fabric, quantity, amount, date of purchase, location of purchase and related bank transaction etc. And these may be verified by concerned NJB units.

8. 7 new applications received (from June'17 till Aug'17) for selection as Collaborating agency for JIDS was evaluated and the status is given below.
