Farmers. The following points were deliberated and discussed :-

The activities involved in the **cycle of jute cultivation were discussed** wherein farmers informed that certified seeds of jute are being regularly received through JCI Procurement Centres. They

suggested that seed distribution should place on a Pan-India basis through some All India Networks of Government agencies and projects (such as ATMA Jute Research Centre in Bihar).



ii) The matters relating to crisis of retting



water in the district of Katihar was pointed out by the farmers wherein it was suggested to them that in such cases the intervention through KVK is being planned. It was also advised to use the retting powders and avail technological help and training from the ICAR-CRIJAF or through Jute-ICARE Scheme. Further, it was pointed out by the farmers that due to increase in makhana cultivation and pisciculture, the retting facilities

is affected. The Secretary, NJB advised to adopt suitable mechanism to handle such issues keeping in view of the local preferences.

iii) The Director, ICAR-CRIJAF raised issues relating to climatic change, varietal action plan, labour cost, retting accelerator and diversified products development. Further, he suggested to prepare the proposal for Jute Technology Mission (JTM)-II emphasizing improvisation of quality and productivity of jute by using genomic information and through genetics management approach.

- iv) The farmers also expressed **grievances about the fake National Seed Corporation Ltd. (NSC) seeds** available in the market. The Secretary, NJB assured the farmers to apprise the matter to NSC.
- v) A brief presentation on the proposed project for producing ethanol from jute biomass was given by Dr. A. K. Singh of ICAR-CRIJAF. The Secretary/NJB and others expressed satisfaction

with the proposal and assured consideration of the project under Jute-ICARE Scheme arranging necessary fund.

vi) Additionally, the farmers raised the **issue of raising Minimum Support Price** of jute as the

expenditure incurred for jute cultivation vis-a-



vis the return from it are nominal, consequently, the farmers are demotivated for jute cultivation.

The meeting ended with felicitation of guests and distribution of certificate to the participating farmers.
