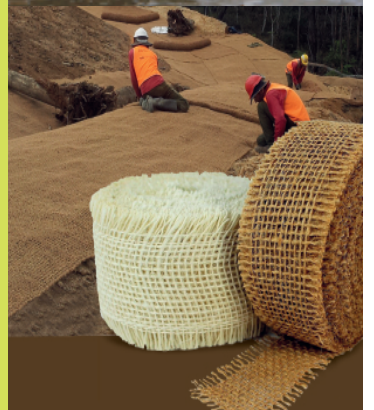
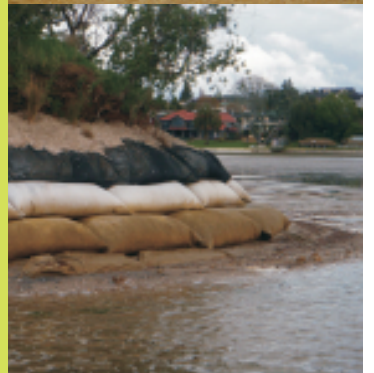

# NATIONAL JUTE BOARD

National Jute Board (NJB) as an apex body of the Ministry of Textiles, Govt. of India is responsible for development of the entire spectrum of the jute sector from agriculture to finished products. NJB is responsible for product & process development and market promotion of jute products being produced by mills and MSME sectors. NJB implements series of activities as per provisions of National Jute Board Act 2008.

**As part of its promotional initiative, NJB implements following schemes for jute sector :**

- **Scheme for Workers' Welfare in the Jute Sector.**

- **For Mill Sector :**

NJB provides assistance to the jute mills for improvement of sanitation, health facilities and working conditions of jute mill workers. The rate of assistance is @ 90% of actual expenses subject to maximum of Rs.40.00 lakh (per mill / annum).

- **For MSMEs :**

NJB, under the scheme of incentive for Social Audit, provides assistance @ 50% of the cost of annual compliance audit subject to maximum of Rs.1.00 lakh (per unit / annum).

- **Scholarship scheme for Children of jute mill workers.**

NJB implements a scheme to extend support to the jute mill workers' family for education of their girl children.

- **Export Market Development Assistance Scheme.**

As part of its export promotion initiative, NJB facilitates regd. manufacturer exporters of jute products to participate in international fairs and business delegations abroad for export promotion of lifestyle and other diversified jute products.





- **Scheme to support supply chain and bulk supply of JDPs for selective and mass consumption.**

As part of promotional initiative, NJB implements a scheme to provide assistance to jute entrepreneurs for opening of outlets of jute lifestyle products in Metro cities, State capitals, District HQs and Tourist spots.

- **Incentive scheme for acquisition of plants and machinery.**

The scheme facilitates modernization and upgradation of technology in jute mills and also the jute entrepreneurs to manufacture value added jute diversified products.

A wide range of hessian bags is manufactured to meet various packaging needs.
